

Using Remote Access with an Apple Mac


This guide is for students and staff who wish to use the Academy remote access system using an Apple Mac based computer. Please see the other guide entitled 'Using Remote Access with a Windows PC' if you are using Windows.

You may already have a version of the Microsoft RDC (Remote Desktop Client) software installed on your Mac, but I would suggest that you go to the 'store' and download the latest version. At the time of writing, Microsoft make no charge for this.
